



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Award for Trustee Excellence

Excellence in Volunteerism Award

Eligibility: To be eligible for the *Award for Trustee Excellence* and *Excellence in Volunteerism Award*, the individual nominated must:

- represent an NHA member hospital in good standing
- have been actively involved with the hospital within the last two years

Entry Requirements:

- Completed nomination form.
- Single-spaced, written narrative describing why the nominee is deserving of the award based on the criteria set forth in the award description (not to exceed three pages).
- Supplementary material pertinent to the nomination may be submitted via e-mail or regular mail. Applications and supplementary materials will not be returned.

Selection Criteria: Nominees will be judged by the NHA Nominating Committee on a 5-point Likert scale. Nomination response must be submitted within the written narrative for all underlined items within the award description.

Award Presentation: Award winners and their nominators will be notified in mid-August.

A public award presentation will be held at the 49th NHA Annual Membership Meeting Awards Luncheon on September 10th at the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe.

NHA will pay the award winner's travel expenses (airfare and/or car mileage expense) to attend the Awards Luncheon. Award winners will also receive a *Congressional Certificate of Commendation* from their respective Congressional representatives, two additional tickets to the Awards Luncheon at the award winner's reserved table, and a boutonniere identifying them as an honoree at the Awards Luncheon.

All nominees will receive a *Certificate of Excellence* from NHA.
