Minimum Dues: \$7,500

TYPE IA General and special hospitals, otherwise eligible for Type I membership, that constitute operating units of multi-hospital systems holding Type V membership.

Rate is same as Type I, discount applied under Type V.

TYPE II Other inpatient care institutions having medical staffs or other direct physician supervision, and having continuous nursing services under professional nurse direction.

Rate is same as Type I Long-Term

TYPE III Organizations other than hospitals for the diagnosis and/or treatment of patients who are primarily ambulatory or specified units of Type I, IA, II or V member.

New hospitals, both general and special, in the planning and/or construction phases until they are in operation.

(Dues are the lowest for the category of membership that hospital will assume when they become operational.)

TYPE V

Organizations (corporate headquarters, mother houses, provincial headquarters or similar entities) which own and operate two or more hospitals eligible for Type IA membership, and which comply with all appropriate provisions of Section IX of the Administrative Regulations of the Board.

Each Type V member shall pay dues computed in the following manner: (1) the dues for each Type IA unit of the multi-hospital system shall be computed at the Type I Short-Term or Type I Long-Term rate for which it would have been eligible had the unit not been categorized as a Type IA member; (2) the dues so calculated for each unit of the Type V system shall be aggregated, except that a multi-system discount of two percent (2%) per hospital, maximum 20% per system, be applied to reduce that amount of total dues, if any, that is in excess of the highest dues paid by a Type I or IA Short-Term member. The total dues payable by any multi-hospital system eligible for application of the multi-system discount may not be reduced below the highest dues payable by a Type I or IA Short-Term member.

<u>TYPE VI</u> Licensed hospitals not located in Illinois and which are members of their state hospital association:

TYPE VII

General and special state or federal government hospitals whose services are not generally available to the public.
